## **RATIONALE**

Breast cancer continues to represent a major global health challenge, characterized by biological heterogeneity and rapidly evolving therapeutic strategies. Significant advances in screening, diagnostics, loco-regional interventions, and systemic therapies have improved patient outcomes, yet they have also increased the complexity of clinical decision-making. As a result, there is a growing need for continuous, high-level education that integrates multidisciplinary perspectives and translates innovation into clinical practice. This scientific event, featuring a world-leading expert in breast cancer, is designed to provide participants with comprehensive and up-to-date insights across the full continuum of care.
